The New London Board of Education has made available a New London Adult High School Diploma to residents who meet certain requirements. Day and evening classes are held at Three Shaw's Cove, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m.

• Individuals eligible for the program must be at least 17 years of age and officially withdrawn from school. (Students under the age of 18 must present a withdrawal document with a parental/ guardian signature). This includes Adult High School Credit Diploma and GED students.

Transitions Program

The Transitions Program is available to all current GED, Credit Diploma and ESL students enrolled at New London Adult and Continuing Education. Jobs, Education and Training

Digital Literacy

Northstar Digital Literacy defines the basic skills needed to perform tasks on computers and online. Modules assess the ability of individuals to perform tasks based on these skills. Included are basic computer digital literacy standards and modules in 3 main areas:

• Essential Computer Skills • Essential Software Skills • Using Technology in Daily Life

Northstar was developed in response to the needs of job seekers who may lack the digital literacy skills needed to seek, obtain, and retain employment, as well as to perform other tasks in daily life.

Individuals who receive a score of at least 85% on a proctored assessment completed at New London Adult Education can earn the **Northstar Digital Literacy Certificate.**

Family Literacy

Where parents and children learn together

The family literacy program includes four components: adult and parenting education, early childhood education, and interactive literacy activities for the parent and child. The adults attend ESL, high school completion, or GED classes with the focus on improving the skills necessary to lead to employment or post-secondary training.

The adults are enrolled in parenting classes designed to assist them in becoming their child's first teacher.

The children participate in an age-appropriate early learning program to prepare them for transition to kindergarten and future academic success. Literacy in the home is fostered through parent and child activities centered on children's books and strategies introduced during parenting class.



Program Merges Basic Education, Vocational Training

The Integrated Basic Education and Skills Training (I-BEST) program engages basic education and vocational training instructors in the delivery of a collaborative program of contextualized learning that includes 50% instructional overlap. Through a team-teaching approach students work with two teachers in the classroom: one provides job-training and the other teaches basic skills in reading, math or English language. Together, the instructors build a classroom environment that provides maximum support for student success.

These trainings, which allow students to explore possible career pathways, focus on a variety of industry clusters and include employability skills. Students can train for a career or higher paying job but can continue to work on their math, reading, high school diploma or English skills at the same time. Students get the help they need while studying in the career field of their choice; they learn by doing!



Microsoft Office Specialist Certification

The Microsoft Office Specialist Certification: Word, Power-Point, Excel and Outlook program teaches valuable skills that will help the student obtain an entry-level position or start a career pathway in the IT field. After successfully completing the classroom, lab, and homework requirements, the student will receive a certificate. Students will prepare to take the National Microsoft Office Specialist Certification exam.

Certified Nursing Assistant

The Certified Nursing Assistant program will provide students with basic nursing skills, classroom and clinical training which includes medical terminology. The program offers the opportunity to receive real life-based experience and practical training. Clinical training is completed in the state-of-the-art lab/ classroom at New London Adult Education and a local nursing facility. The training course will include a basic skills education component. Upon successful completion of the course, students will take the State of Connecticut exam for CNA certification.







100 Emergency Medical Technician Initial Basic Training

101 PHLEBOTOMY

This flexible learning program will provide students the skills necessary to work as a CPT. Students will learn the components of blood, possible complications of a blood draw, along with some basic Human Anatomy, proper drawing technique, and collection sequence. In order to complete this class it is a requirement to obtain 30 successful venipuncture collections and 10 capillary draws on living persons. These will be performed in class on fellow students and clinical volunteers. This is an 80 hour hybrid course with 70 hours of online learning and 10 hours of in person clinical. Upon successful completion of this course students will have the opportunity to obtain National Certification from the NHA if they successfully pass the exam.

102 Certified Nursing Assistant Training

Our CNA program will provide students with the required hours for Certified Nursing Assistant training, basic nurse aide skills, including classroom and clinical training. All students should expect to need to be Co-vid-19 tested weekly during the class. It is the responsibility of each student to have this done. 103 OSHA 10-hour Construction Course

The OSHA 10 Construction training covers specific OSHA regulations and requirements as they apply to the Construction Industry. Workers who successfully complete the OSHA-authorized course will earn the official OSHA 10 card from the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL). The course covers safety and health hazards workers may face on construction work sites, placing special emphasis on hazard identification, avoidance, control, and prevention. Students are required to attend the full 10 hours and pass the tests to receive the OSHA 10 29CFR1926 Construction Card. This class can be credited toward the 30-hour class, providing the class is by the same instructor and is completed 6 months from the initial 10 hour completion.
